Dear Parents/Guardians,

Sorry for the delay in relaying information to you, but I have had to wait for all information to be made available to me. As we stand the school will be partially open but we have had to make adjustments to our risk assessment in order to reflect the increased risk we currently face due to growing Covid-19 numbers and the new strain. However, for the classes that are open we have had to make changes to arrival and collection procedures so please read the information below carefully. These changes will initially be for two weeks and will then be reviewed based on the advice available to us and the national situation.

I would like to reassure parents that we have put as many safety measures in place to minimise risks and protect children staff and our school families. Tomorrow we will be organising key worker provision in case of a full National lockdown and for those classes that are currently accessing remote learning.
